Eligibility & Application Process

- Are you 60+ or an adult with disabilities looking for low-income housing? Congregate Housing units are available in Bridgewater, Stoughton, and Marshfield.
- What is Congregate Housing? Congregate Housing is a shared living environment where residents have their own private bedroom and share living space, kitchens, and sometimes bathrooms.
- Please apply online by using the Common Housing Application for Massachusetts Public-Housing (CHAMP) application and checking off the Congregate box, or by contacting the Bridgewater, Marshfield, or Stoughton Housing Authorities. Visit <https://publichousingapplication.ocd.state.ma.us>.

- Congregate Housing Programs are designed to offer support to residents while allowing them to maintain their independence.
