## Supportive Housing

Allows older adults and people with disabilities to age in place. This program integrates the delivery of community-based services within each housing complex.

The program is designed to create a supportive living environment in which residents have access to personal care and other support services seven days a week.

## Available Services

OCES' Supportive Housing Specialist is available each weekday to coordinate programs, services and activities. The specialist will provide you with information and referral to legal, health, counseling and other community services. Depending on eligibility, some or all of the following services may be available to residents:

- care management
- chore
- 24/7 emergency response
- escort to meals
- grocery shopping/put away
- laundry
- light housekeeping
- meal program
- medication reminder
- personal care
- safety checks
- social/educational activities

## Resident Information

All residents are eligible for information and referral services, emergency response, medication reminders, safety checks and social/education programs.

The specialist can assist residents in accessing OCES' other programs and services. To be eligible for regularly scheduled support services through OCES, a resident will need to either meet program guidelines or pay privately.
